What? The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and income
- account balances and payment history
- credit history and credit scores

When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How? All financial companies need to share customer's personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customer's personal information; the reasons Lincoln Federal Savings Bank chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do	
How does Lincoln Federal Savings Bank protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Lincoln Federal Savings Bank collect my personal information?	 We collect your personal information, for example, when you open an account or show your government-issued ID apply for a loan or provide account information make deposits or withdrawals from your account We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	 Federal law gives you the right to limit only sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness affiliates from using your information to market you sharing for nonaffiliates to market you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.Lincoln Federal Savings Bank does not share with our affiliates.
Nonaffiliates	 Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Lincoln Federal Savings Bank does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market you.
Joint marketing	 A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Lincoln Federal Savings Bank does not jointly market.
